Procedure

- WHO
 - The Investigating Authority makes the decision and shares it
- WHEN
 - If the decision made after the submissons immediately notify the interested party
 - If it is figured out during the verification- official report is signed, decison and notification is made after an evaluation at the department

Informing the Interested parties

- The possibility of facts available is shared
 - While sending the initial questionnaires
 - In deficiency letters
 - In verification letters
 - And then in disclosures

- Late Submission
 - Submission of the questionnaire after the deadlines
 - Submission of some data in deficiency letters after the deadlines
- Partial/Incomplete Information
 - Is it possible to calculate the dumping margin (i.e Cost, sales info present-operating statistics or PNL is not)
 - General integrity
 - Lack of the supporting documentation

- Deliberately misleading info
 - May lead to non cooperation
- Mistakes made by the interested parties that effect the result
 - After the deficiency letters
 - During the verification

- Lack of submission by some entities
 - Importers
 - Traders
 - Related firms (i.e. Raw material suppliers, Distributors)
- Format issues
 - Language
 - Computerized response

- Inability to verify-because of whom?
 - Investigation authorithy
 - Interested party
 - «force majeure»

What data is used as Facts Available?

- If possible use data in their submission (i.e other types' averages)
- Use other parties data as well (i.e.other parties cost data by type)
- May use information provided in the application (i.e. product type or cost data)
 - We verify that data since dumping and injury is made both by the same department
