Journal of International Trade is issuing a Call for Papers to be published in its Second Volume in 2017 on issues within the area of International Trade. JIT invites articles, case comments, book reviews and reflections by students, academicians, practitioners and negotiators in the sphere of international trade law, international trade economics and international trade policy.

JIT is an annual blind peer-reviewed journal of the Centre for WTO Studies. The journal aims to provide an inter-disciplinary platform for the exchange of views on issues of world trade with particular focus on encouraging practical perspectives and developmental issues. One of the main objectives of the journal is to serve as a primary reference point on issues that interests academicians and practitioners in the field.

The journal's scope of publication for Volume II includes the following themes:

- E-Commerce.
- Changing architecture on rules in services.
- Development implications of strong IPR protection.

Legal/economic/policy manuscripts under the above themes will be considered for publication. Authors may note that any analysis solely limited to a national system will fall outside the scope of the JIT. An international legal or economic dimension is imperative.
