IIFT is a premier institution of education, training and research in the area of International Business set up by Department of Commerce, Government of India.

The Centre for Regional Trade has been established at the Indian Institute of Foreign Trade in December, 2016. Centre is a professional body which undertake research on trade and investment, issues relevant to specific regions/countries, including Africa, ASEAN, China, EU, Japan, Korea, etc. from the perspective of implications for India and other developing countries; For its research work, the Centre intends to engage Researchers either at the level of Research Associate (Economics) or Research Fellow (Economics) to look after international trade issues. The engagement shall be purely on contractual basis for a period of one year. The candidate should possess the following qualification:

MA(Eco)/MA(International trade)/M.Phil (Economics) with sound knowledge of computer application and packages [M.S. Word, M.S. Access, M.S. Outlook, Excel, Power Point]. The candidate should have good command over English (spoken as well as written) and should have interest in research activities.

Experience: The candidates having experience in research activities particularly international trade issues in any reputed organization shall be preferred.

Tenure: The appointment will be purely on contractual basis for a period of one year with a possibility of further extension based on the performance.

Emoluments: The Researchers shall be paid fixed monthly emoluments depending upon their qualification and experience as under:

Research Associate: Rs.25, 000/- per month

Research Fellow : Rs.30, 000/- per month

In addition, incumbent shall be entitled to medical facilities, Earned Leave, etc. as applicable.

The selected candidate will need to join immediately.

Indian nationals having the above qualifications and experience should only apply and send their c.v. by email to Shri A.K. The shortlisted candidates shall be called for written test, computer skill test and interview before the Selection Committee at the Centre for W.T.O. Studies (7th Floor), Indian Institute of Foreign Trade, B-21, Qutab Institutional Area, New Delhi – 110016 (near Rockland Hospital), Opposite Katwaria Sarai. The date and time of the test and interview shall be intimated to the shortlisted candidates only in due course. It is also brought to the notice of all concerned that no TA/DA shall be payable to the candidates appearing for written test and interview and that the candidates coming from outside Delhi shall have to make their own arrangements for stay in Delhi and the Centre shall neither pay nor arrange for their accommodation.
