The SDoC the key of trust

SDoC >>>> Supplier's Declaration of Conformity



- With the right key the EU-door will be opened for **PRODUCTS** from third countries
- The industry is responsible for the key

Legal frame work > EU Decision 768/2008/EC

How to contact manufacturers?

- **Manufacturers or their representatives**
- **General Risk based approach**
- **In case of**
 - non-compliant(ce) products
- **Action to market surveillance authorities**
 - Safeguard procedure
- **Dangerous products<> withdrawn of the EU market**
 - Informing Commission and Member States
 - RAPEX electronic system
 - To inform the Commission and other Member States



How to check conformity of products

- **Technical documentation file**
- **The Technical Documentation contains all relevant technical information and tests which must confirm and prove that all the essential requirements set out in the CE certification directives have been met.**

•If not using the route of harmonised standards:

•Opinion notified body in case of not using



Technical documentation (1)

- **Authorities have legal right to obtain all relevant technical information to check the assessment conformity**
- **Files are strictly for the authorities**
- **Confidentiality of the files**
- **Full cooperation of the manufacturers**
- **10 year period after > last product manufactured**



Technical documentation (2)

- **Legal basis is mentioned in the Directives**
 - **General description of product**
 - **Conceptual design**
 - **Applicable (harmonised Standard's)**
 - **Results of design calculations**
 - **Test reports**
 - **Updating information**
 - **Information from involved the Notified Body**
 - **For the R&TTE Directive a guide for industry is available**



Supplier's declaration of conformity

- The compliance of a product with all relevant essential requirements is declared in an “EC” Supplier's Declaration of Conformity (SDoC) issued by the manufacturer
- SDoC is an “official” declaration, it must be signed by a person “empowered to bind the manufacturer or his authorised representative, located in the European Union”.
- The layout of the SDoC can take any form as long as the minimum required relevant information is provided
- The SDoC should conform annex 3 (Dec.768/2008/EC)






Essential requirements



EU market surveillance products

- 27 market national surveillance authorities' responsibility in the EU



The Netherlands

Member States are responsible for the EU

25 % products are passing through the harbour of Rotterdam



Cooperation Market surveillance authorities

- **Market surveillance is an EU matter**
- **Cooperation between these authorities**
- **27 members, included**
 - **Switzerland, Norway and Iceland**
- **Administrative Cooperation, called ADCO**
- **Different ADCO's (ADCO/LVD. ADCO/EMC etc.)**
- **Cross border campaigns**
- **Electronic system of exchange of information**
- **Exchange national programmes**



European cross border campaigns

- **MSA >>> cross border MS campaigns**
- **Results non-compliance of mass products**
 - Radio Short range devices > 80 %
 - Electrical tools lower than > 72 %
 - Low power FM transmitters > 42 %
- **Most non-compliant (ce) equipment come from third countries (China, Korea)**



Experiences with third countries and industry

- **Some mass products from third countries are not traceable**
- **High level of non compliance of mass products**
- **General no EC marking**
- **Name of manufacturer is missing**
- **Not willing to deliver the technical file construction**
- **Different importers in the EU**
 - **who is responsible for placing on the EU market?**
 - **Importers are informed about EU regulations**
