Smita Miglani is Consultant (Economics) at the Centre for WTO Studies, Indian Institute of Foreign Trade, New Delhi. She is an economist and trade policy advisor with around 15 years of experience in international trade and economic policy. In her present role, she has been working for Government of India's feasibility studies for international trade agreements and WTO issues, covering both goods and services. Her work also involves quantitative and qualitative assessment of trade agreements through CGE modelling and econometric analysis. Her broad areas of research include manufacturing policy, trade in goods and services, energy and G20 issues. She has also been part of the Centre's training programmes on international trade issues conducted under the India Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC) initiative of the Ministry of External Affairs.
