Bhanu Kalra is a Research Fellow at the Centre for WTO Studies, Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (IIFT), where she provides research and policy support to the Department of Commerce, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, on international trade and WTO-related matters.

She has worked extensively with the Multilateral Trade Negotiations Wing of the Department of Commerce, contributing to India's engagement in multilateral trade matters. Her work included supporting India's preparedness for the 14th WTO Ministerial Conference as well as India's 8th Trade Policy Review. Her work on the TPR involved research and analysis of trade policy issues, preparation of inputs and responses to Members' questions, and coordination of inputs across Ministries and Departments. She has also participated in the TPR meetings and undertook thematic analysis of Members' interventions to support India's review process.

Her areas of work also include trade policy analysis, trade in goods, global supply chain resilience, and trade data analysis. She has worked on FTA feasibility studies, tariff and market access analysis, assessment of export opportunities for India, and quantitative analysis of bilateral and Sectoral trade data. She has contributed to supply chain resilience research through data-driven analysis of critical imports, early warning systems, stakeholder consultations, and preparation of analytical reports and policy inputs to support India's trade negotiations and strategic interests.

Bhanu holds an M.A. in Economics from SNDT Women's University, Mumbai, and a B.A. (Hons.) in Economics from Shivaji College, University of Delhi.
