She has also contributed to the development and maintenance of the Centre's SPS and TBT Web Portal. Over the course of her career at the Centre, she has conducted research and provided analytical inputs to the Department of Commerce on a wide range of trade policy issues, including SPS and TBT measures, market access, standards, and WTO-related other trade regulatory matters. Her work spans both multilateral and bilateral trade policy engagements.
