I. Usage of trade remedy measures

1. Antidumping

- * 84 cases in total since 1997, involving 74 products;
- According to WTO statistics, 221 investigations till now, ranking No.8 in all WTO Members;
- * 82 cases finished, among which 69 ended up with antidumping measures

- * 13 cases completed with no measure, due to:
- 1) No injury;
- No dumping or *de minimis* Dumping margin;
- 3) Withdrawal of application;
- Ruling of administrative review •

Forms of Measure depending upon case-specific circumstance:

- Ad valorem duty;
- 2) Price undertaking;
- 3) Shortening application period;
- Suspension of application;
- Partial expiry of measures in sunset;
- 6) Termination due to industry cooperation.

- * Among 69 cases with measures imposed, 26 have expired within maximum 10 years' application;
- Industry coverage majors in traditional sectors, such as chemical, steel, paper, etc.
- * Recent development shows tendency towards other sectors like high tech, new energy products.
- Places of Origin of imports include 27 countries or regions, among which US, Japan, EU and Korea are top 4.

2. Countervailing Duty and Safeguards

- * 7 CVD cases initiated against US and EU since 2009 and all finished;
- 6 cased ended up with CVD imposed and so far 5 are still in effectiveness;
- China is not a major users of safeguard measures with only 1 case taking place 13 years ago and the measure terminated already.

* 3. Basic ideas:

- Abiding by WTO rules and domestic law;
- Focusing on fairness, un-biasedness, reasonability and appropriateness, limiting to reasonable relief to domestic industries;
- Constructing fair competition-friendly trade environment and promoting development of global free trade;
- Strengthening multilateral and bilateral communications and exchange, improving and perfecting practices.

 II. Investigations and Measures taken as Exporting Country

The Biggest Target of antidumping measures for 18 consecutive years and the Biggest Target of countervailing measures for 8 consecutive years

* 1. Antidumping (from 01/01/1995 to 30/06/2014)

- Initiations: 1022; measures: 740, accounting for approximate 1/4 of the total globally;
- Meanwhile Korea (341), Chinese Taipei (257), US (257) and Thailand (189).

* 2. Countervailing Measures

Since 2006, subject to 84 CVD investigations and 53 measures imposed;

Meanwhile Indian (62), Korea (22), Indonesia (18), US (15);

A surge after the Financial Crisis.

* 3. Some Observations:

- General economic background: one of the major manufacturing countries and the largest exporting country in the world;
- Direct economic factor: stronger demand for protection through trade remedy due to still unclear prospect for recovery after financial crisis;

- 3) Industry coverage: shifting from traditional labor-incentive sectors to high-tech, new energy sectors, with huge cases emerging, such as solar penal cases.
- 4) Common practice of some Members: simultaneous AD and CVD investigation against the same product from China, and rapid growth in the number of CVD investigations after financial crisis;
- 5) New path to resolution: settlement through bilateral dialogue and consultation, such as price undertaking signed between China and EN.
