Sunset Reviews

- Are governor under Section 751 of the Tariff Act and Section 351.218 of the Department of Commerce's Regulations.
- Section 751 of the Statue requires the Department and the ITC to conduct a sunset review no later than five years after the issuance of an AD or CVD order.
- Sunset reviews, unlike administrative reviews, are conducted on an order-wide, rather than company-specific basis.

- Interested parties have an opportunity to participate in sunset reviews every 5 years.
- Within 30 days prior to the 5th anniversary of the publication of an order (or suspension agreement) we publish an initiation notice in the <u>Federal Register</u>.
- A month before we initiate a sunset review we publish a notification in the <u>Federal Register</u> as a courtesy to interested parties.

- Domestic interested parties must file a notice of intent to participate w/in 15 days of publication of the notice of initiation.
- Respondent interested parties must file a substantive response w/in 30 days of publication of the notice of initiation.

Factors we consider in making our determination :

- Likelihood of Continuation or Recurrence of Dumping
- Magnitude of Dumping Margin Likely to Prevail

- Likelihood
- 1) Dumping above de minimis
- 2) Imports ceased after order
- 3) Dumping eliminated after order, and import volumes decline

• Magnitude

1) Generally select margins from original investigation

2) May use preliminary margin (e.g., suspended investigation where no final was issued)

3) May use more recently calculated margin

- If both domestic and respondent parties submit adequate substantive responses, the Department shall conduct a full sunset review and will issue a preliminary results no later than 110 days after publication of the initiation notice.
- Preliminary results are issued only for full sunset reviews.
- The Department will conduct an expedited sunset review and bypass preliminary results when only domestic interested parties, and no respondent parties, submit a substantive response.

• Sunset Reviews require a re-examination of injury by the ITC.

• Orders are revoked or suspension agreements are terminated when domestic interested parties do not participate in the sunset review, or when we find that this would not lead to a continuance or recurrence of dumping/unfair subsidization and the ITC finds that revocation or termination would not result in a continuance or recurrence of material injury.
